

Our notes regarding the Underground strike on Tuesday 19 May

Dear attendees,

We are aware that there is a planned Underground strike on Tuesday 19 May. However, it appears that services will operate as normal in the morning until 12pm, with advice that people on affected transport finish travelling by 8pm.

Non-London underground services, including the Elizabeth Line, continue throughout the day and the full strike kicks in after 8pm and continues the next day.

As our event will run from 9.30am to 5.30pm, it is therefore expected to be much less affected by the strike, so **we've decided to proceed with the in-person event as planned.**

We did explore the possibility of offering a hybrid option, but sadly this is not possible at the venue that day.

- Moorgate Station – Stop B: 21, 43, 76, 141, 153 (2-min walk)
- Finsbury Square / Moorgate – Stop K: 21, 43, 76, 141, 153 (3-min walk)
- Finsbury Street – Stop S or R: 153 (2-min walk)
